

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Brooks County Board of Commissioner has tentatively adopted a 2024 millage rate which will require an increase in property tax by 3.33 percent for the unincorporated area and by 5.20 percent for the incorporated area.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on the tax increase to be held at the Brooks County Admin Building, Board of Commissioners meeting room, 610 S Highland Rd, Quitman on August 7, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the Brooks County Admin Building, Board of Commissioners meeting room, 610 S Highland Rd, Quitman on August 19, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 12.475 mills, an increase of .402 mills for the unincorporated area. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than 12.073 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of 175,000 is approximately 28.00 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of 200,000 is approximately 32.00.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 14.287 mills, an increase of .706 mills for the incorporated area. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than 13.581 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of 175,000 is approximately 49.00 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of 200,000 is approximately 57.00.
