Beginning January 1st, 2026, the below codes will be the minimum construction codes in Brooks County, Georgia.

The Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Board, upon recommendation of the State Codes Advisory Committee (SCAC), voted to adopt the following codes with an effective date of January 1, 2026:
